Want to recycle more? You can recycle all of the following:

- Glass bottles and jars (remove lids)
- Plastic bottles and jugs (remove lids)
- Empty aerosol cans (remove lids and tips)
- Aluminum cans and steel cans
- Cardboard
- Newspaper and magazines
- Office paper
- Brown grocery bags
- Junk mail and envelopes
- Clean pizza boxes
- Paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes, etc.)
- Phone books and catalogs
