Ordinance No. 14 20 24

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO RECONSTRUCT ROLSTON AVENUE FROM WAYNE AVENUE TO DALE ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood has applied for and been awarded a grant/loan from Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) in the amount not to exceed \$2,537,000.00 for the reconstruction of Rolston Avenue from Wayne Avenue to Dale Road; and

WHEREAS, in order to minimize the City's costs for the reconstruction project referred to above, and to comply with Ohio public contracting law, the City of Norwood must advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the work referred to above, within the City of Norwood; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the reconstruction of Rolston Avenue from Wayne Avenue to Dale Road, and to enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director, in an amount not to exceed \$2,537,000.00, with OPWC Funding, **Capital Project Fund 4046**, in the form of a grant/loan of 50% of the project cost with the other 50% to be drawn from the **Streets Maintenance and Repair Fund 2002**.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw, and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay, warrants in the amounts stated in the contract out of the funds referred to in Section 1.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to get this project started quickly to provide the best chance to complete the project this calendar year.
